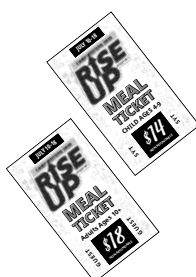

First Aid is available from Friday evening, July 10 to Sunday morning, July 18.

Prayer Spots Walk

Intercessory Prayer

Be the person who opens space for conversations with God. When you chat with someone, ask, "Is it okay with you if I pray for you?" If they say yes, then do it! If they say no, tell them, "That is fine. Have a great day."

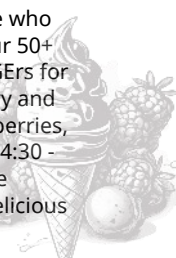
